State Board to Hold Special, Telephonic Meeting Policy Committee to Meet at Randolph Community College

RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will meet telephonically for a specially called meeting on Friday, June 19 to discuss a short list of time sensitive items. The board’s Policy Committee will hold a working session for Thursday, June 18 to discuss the [Study on Admission of Undocumented Students into the North Carolina Community College System](#). No other State Board committees will meet as the June 19 meeting was set outside the regular meeting schedule.

The Policy Committee is open to the public and begins at 10 a.m. at Randolph Community College’s Foundation Conference Center in Asheboro.

The full board will convene via telephone on Friday, June 19 at 9 a.m. for a special, abbreviated meeting to discuss time sensitive issues.
